Blankets/Summer Sun	Settle  Jerry Brillo  Yoli Hasler	Summer Sun respite & donation flyers are distributed to the TPCH list serve, the Ward 5 homeless coalition, and posted on <a href="http://www.tpch.net">www.tpch.net</a> .  There is no word yet on delivery of the current blanket order.  TSA is distributing water to Stone & Speedway and Sta. Rita Parks when the temp is 102+. They took 15 cases to RAPP yesterday, per Yoli Hasler. People from Esteban Park come to them for water. Sunglasses come in regularly and go out as quickly as they come in. Publications Update	Settle  Bill Finch	<i>Need Help</i> and <i>Guidelines on Getting Out</i> are in distribution, with a possibility of Guidelines distribution throughout parole and probation and reprinting using Continuum of Care planning grant funds.  When are updates scheduled? This has usually been as needed, but should soon be part of an annual schedule. Staff receives updates on an ongoing basis and adds them to the online <i>Need Help?</i> as they are received. The online <i>Need Help?</i> becomes the basis for the next annual update.	Staff emails alerts when printed updates are planned.  Anyone with updates will send them to TPCH staff as the updates occur.
New Business	Pam Moseley  Adair Brown  Yoli  DeDe	Our community seems to lack adequate family emergency shelter, and needs to engage in conversation and planning to assist families who lose their housing. FEMA and ESG funds for motel vouchers are limited and sporadic. This group may need to begin exploration of need and potential funding as well as planning to meet this emergency housing need.  Brainstorming included: rent hotel/motel rooms and/or apartments in various parts of the city to accommodate families.  Our Family Services has scattered site family shelter in apartments leased in their names (and into which they can transition to renters), but it still takes up to a week to find the apartment, incurring hotel costs. In short, it's not same-day shelter.  Our community needs an outreach worker specializing in the elderly. They have a difficult time serving their specific needs, such a medications & long-term care.  The Hospitality House held a Memorial Day dinner for guests, invited Camp Bravo residents & sent about 30 meals back to the base for those who couldn't attend.  DeDe will email directions to the new meeting site. Parking is free for meeting attendees.	Pam will bring Housing Inventory Chart (HIC) and HMIS data for consideration for the subcommittee.  The July meeting will consider the issue. Staff will invite all shelter providers.  The Hospitality House will host any outreach worker who wishes to meet with elderly guests.
