Merchant Association issues	Megan / Jackson	Youth count at Metro went well, 46 people signed in. Debriefing this afternoon at Plaza Arboleda, 3-5pm. Data entry took place yesterday. 4 <sup>th</sup> ave. Merchant Association showed up frustrated due to attracting homeless youth, police were called. It's a good idea to inform the 4 <sup>th</sup> ave. Merchants Association of what's going on, so there is no repeat of the frustrations this year. We should reach out & inform businesses in this area about this population. There may be travelers that come & go, but we are witnessing an increased inflow of people experiencing homelessness. When on 4 <sup>th</sup> ave., introduce yourself to store managers & let them know what you're doing, so they may help reach out & locate clients matched with housing. Inform people about sitting & smoking ordinances. Megan will present this to CoS.  Megan went through surveys, 14 age 24 & under youth counted that were category 1; 12 couch surfing; several age 25+ category 1; some people will not be able to be counted due to lack of information.
