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Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds are available through the Primavera Foundation's Homeless Intervention & Prevention (HIP) program to assist with acquiring replacement Arizona Identification or obtaining the source documents required by ADOT to acquire Arizona Identification.

### **SERVING**

- Individuals or families with a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings, including but not limited to a car, park, abandoned buildings, bus or train station, airport, or camping ground
- Individuals or families living in a supervised publicly or privately operated shelter designated to provide temporary living arrangements (including but not limited to congregate shelters, transitional housing, and hotels or motels paid for by charitable organizations or by federal, state, or local government programs for low-income individuals)
